Your sponsorship will help expand our community and knowledge based solutions to common problems we face in the capital projects industry.

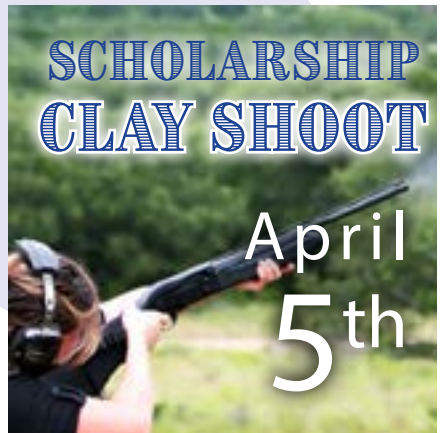
