After the first LinCP Forum in February, 2009, I was encouraged by the participants to form a nonprofit organization and to take the Forums around Texas. The **Institute for Leadership in Capital Projects (I-LinCP)** was formed as a Texas nonprofit corporation in January, 2010 and gained nonprofit IRS 501-c-3 status in May, 2011.

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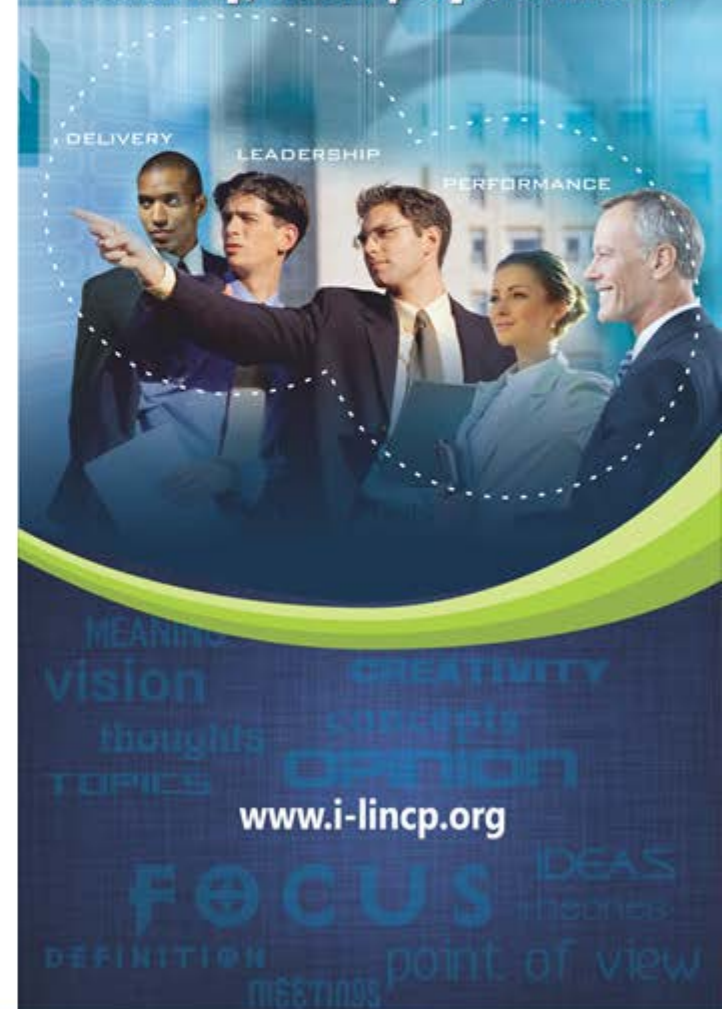
